



The “ONE DROP CAN CAUSE A FLOOD” is our annual campaign that serves as flood’s ongoing fundraising initiative by encouraging students to get sponsorship for their service work in the community as well as provide opportunities for families and individuals to sponsor students that serve with flood. With this campaign, 20% of the amount raised goes directly to either a student’s school chapter, supplies for one of our SERVE NOW projects, or organizational expenses.

This sponsorship packet includes what students need to be successful in telling stories about their service work, sharing their heart about how important it is, and raising support for their work in the community. The sponsorship levels and items individuals will receive at each level are listed below. We encourage students to go above and beyond the sponsorship levels because 20% of the raised support can go directly back into a school chapter or a project that students love!

Sponsorship Levels

<i>Get yourself sponsored</i>	<i>1 Drop</i>	<i>\$144 a year</i>	<i>Bracelet</i>
<i>Get yourself and one other student sponsored</i>	<i>2 Drops</i>	<i>\$288 a year:</i>	<i>Bracelet, T-shirt</i>
<i>Get yourself and 3 other students sponsored</i>	<i>4 Drops</i>	<i>\$576 a year:</i>	<i>Bracelet, T-shirt Water bottle</i>

Tips for Successful Support Raising

- 1. Be familiar with the Vision and Mission of flood***
- 2. Share your serving stories***
- 3. Share your heart and why serving is important to you***
- 4. Decide if you will call, email, or visit your potential sponsor***
- 5. A face to face ask always works best***
- 6. Follow back up if necessary***
- 7. Practice your request before you ask***
- 8. All sponsorship is tax deductible as flood is a 501©3 non-profit organization***
- 9. Give the flood website address (www.floodstudentmissions.org) for potential sponsors to see what flood is all about***
- 10. Track your sponsorship by using the enclosed form***
- 11. Say thank you no matter if someone sponsors you or not***
- 12. Checks can be made out to: flood student missions***
- 13. Always pray before you ask someone to sponsor you. God already knows who will sponsor you so don't have any expectations except for His!***
